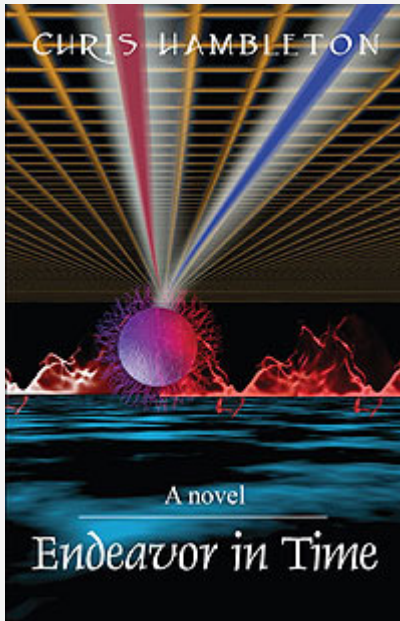


# Endeavor in Time



## BOOK SUMMARY
